How Does the Program Benefit Students in My Area?

- Helps to nurture creativity through music and provides a healthy outlet for expressing emotion through such activities as songwriting and composition
- Provides group interaction, dialogue, and coaching with a touring professional musician and other performance arts industry experts
- Builds self-confidence and a healthy self-esteem through group participation (playing an instrument is not required)
- Single and multi-week programs may be offered as well as single experiential days focusing on songwriting, musicality, performance and understanding aspects of the music industry and careers in music.

Program Details:

- Programs will be conducted Monday – Thursday during after school hours for a minimum of 1 week to multi-weeks based on school input and student availability.
- Programs are targeted to youth age 11 – 18 years old
- Programs will accommodate approximately 20 students up to a maximum of 40 students per group. All programs based on funding availability.

Curriculum includes:

- Introduction to Various Careers in the Music Industry
 - Understanding the Basics of Songwriting and Co-Writing
 - Having Fun with Music
 - Blending Melodies & Syllables
 - What is Commercialization of Music
 - Understanding Rhythms, Rhyming, and Cadence
 - Navigating the Business Side of Music
 - Understanding Performance, Touring, Band Interaction & Accountabilities
